



SOFTWARE LICENSE AGREEMENT AND WARRANTY STATEMENT

(End-User Perpetual License/Redistribution Prohibited)

BRODIEWARE LIMITED, D/B/A NEWHAVEN SOFTWARE (NHS) IS WILLING TO LICENSE THE SOFTWARE ONLY UPON THE CONDITION THAT YOU (YOU, END USER) ACCEPT ALL OF THE TERMS CONTAINED IN THIS LICENSE AGREEMENT. PLEASE READ THE TERMS CAREFULLY BEFORE OPENING THE PRODUCT PACKAGE AND INSTALLING THE SOFTWARE, AS OPENING THE PRODUCT PACKAGE AND INSTALLING THE SOFTWARE WILL INDICATE YOUR AGREEMENT WITH THEM. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE WITH THESE TERMS, THEN NHS IS UNWILLING TO LICENSE THE SOFTWARE TO YOU, IN WHICH EVENT YOU SHOULD RETURN THE SOFTWARE, AND IF YOU PAID A LICENSE FEE, YOU WILL RECEIVE A REFUND SUBJECT TO ANY LIMITATIONS SET FORTH IN THE PURCHASE AGREEMENT AND/OR INVOICE(S).

1. **The Software.** The Software licensed under this Agreement consists of computer programs, data compilation(s), and documentation referred to as Commerce Management System (CMS) Versions 1.x and later (the "Software").
2. **Perpetual Term.** The term of the license granted herein shall be perpetual unless terminated by written notice by You for convenience or terminated by either party for material breach. Immediately upon termination of this license for any reason, You shall return to NHS all copies of the Software and documentation.
3. **License Grant (Single Server or Network; Concurrent User).** You are granted non-exclusive rights to install and use the Software on one Server or a single dedicated computer acting as a server and/or transmit the Software over an internal computer network, provided You acquire and dedicate a licensed copy of the Software for each user who may access the Software concurrently with any other user. The Software server license may not be installed on more than one computer. The Software workstation license(s) may be installed on any or all computer(s) on the same network. The Software includes a software mechanism which locks out any concurrent users in excess of the number of licensed copies of the Software, and includes electronic registration technology to prevent unauthorized copying, duplication or installation. You may copy the Software for inactive backup and archival purposes only, provided that any copy must contain the original Software's copyright, government restricted rights and other proprietary notices or legends in unaltered form. Although copyrighted, the Software (and embedded runtime programs) is unpublished and contains proprietary and confidential information of NHS, its licensors and suppliers. You agree to maintain the Software in confidence and use a reasonable degree of care to protect the confidentiality of the Software.

4. Restrictions. You may not: (i) permit others to use the Software, except as expressly provided above for authorized network use; (ii) modify or translate the Software; (iii) reverse engineer, decompile, or disassemble the Software, except to the extent this restriction is expressly prohibited by applicable law; (iv) create derivative works based on the Software; (v) merge the Software with another product; (vi) copy the Software, except as expressly provided above; (vii) remove or obscure any proprietary rights notices or labels on the Software; or (viii) use any of the embedded runtime programs for application development purposes or other use(s) outside of the intended scope of the Software.

5. Transfers. You may not transfer the Software or any rights under this Agreement without the prior written consent of NHS, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld. A condition to any transfer or assignment shall be that the recipient agrees to the terms of this Agreement. You may be required to pay a license transfer fee prior to receiving any written consent for transfer or assignment. Any attempted transfer or assignment in violation of this provision shall be null and void.

6. Ownership. NHS and its suppliers own the Software and all intellectual property rights embodied therein, including copyrights and valuable trade secrets embodied in the Software's design and coding methodology. The Software is protected by United States copyright laws and international treaty provisions. This Agreement provides You only a limited use license, and no ownership of any intellectual property.

NHS AND ITS SUPPLIERS SPECIFICALLY DISCLAIM THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF TITLE, NON-INFRINGEMENT, MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, SYSTEM INTEGRATION, AND DATA ACCURACY. THERE IS NO WARRANTY OR GUARANTEE THAT THE OPERATION OF THE SOFTWARE WILL BE UNINTERRUPTED, ERROR-FREE, OR VIRUS-FREE, OR THAT THE SOFTWARE WILL MEET ANY PARTICULAR CRITERIA OF PERFORMANCE, QUALITY, ACCURACY, PURPOSE, OR NEED. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be unenforceable for any reason, such provision shall be reformed only to the extent necessary to make it enforceable. This Agreement shall be construed under the laws of the State of Washington, USA, excluding rules regarding conflicts of law. This license is written in English and English is its controlling language.

AUDIT RIGHTS. NHS shall have the right to conduct and/or direct an independent accounting firm to conduct, during normal business hours, an audit of the appropriate records of the End User to verify the number of copies of the Software Program in Use, the computer systems on which such copies are installed and the number of Seats or Concurrent Users.
